

WHAT'S UP AT THE BIA

CCTV CAMERAS

- There have been ongoing discussions with the OPP's Community Mobilization Unit regarding the safety of the Downtown and preventative measures. The CMU has offered the following CCTV program suggestion:
 - Ontario CCTV Grant as part of the Guns, Gangs and Violence Reduction Strategy can cover up to 50% of project costs up to \$200 000.

There will be an info session to update stats on downtown crime and calls for service

STAFF PARKING ADVOCACY

• The BIA is advocating for a Downtown Business Employee Parking strategy. We are currently researching methods other cities have employed to assist with the retention of employees in downtowns with paid parking.

SEAGULL REDUCTION

- Our Falconer was able to successfully retrieve 800 eggs, and as of their last check in no other eggs were found
- We have experienced a dramatic decrease in seagull activity in the core
- The Falconer has submitted the logs and egg retrieval to the Ministry to comply with the Provincial protection standards in place for these migratory birds

WHAT IS A BIA?

A Business Improvement Area (BIA) is a "made-in-Ontario" innovation that allows local business people and commercial property owners and tenants to join together and, with the support of the municipality, to organize, finance, and carry out physical improvements and promote economic development in their district.

WHAT IS THE MANDATE OF A BIA?

- To oversee the improvement, beautification, and maintenance of the area
- Promote the BIA as a business or shopping area
- Undertake safety & security initiatives within the BIA
- Undertake strategic planning necessary to address BIA issues
- Advocate on behalf of the interests of the business improvement area
