The DOBIA light strands require thorough inspection for repair and replacement. Summer beautification initiatives include purchasing 30 planters and plant inserts for \$2500 to create an improved experience and reduce asset movement. Members are encouraged to decorate for pride and especially for the Pride on the Patio event. Streets Alive has a a

budget request for \$2500 to cover the Peter St. corner fences in reusable greenery. Due to unforeseen events the mural portion of the project is postponed.

While the board prefers option ‘A’ for design, they still have concerns regarding the lifespan of the infrastructure below ground level and request an up-to-date engineering report for underground infrastructure in order to support the project as it has been presented.

In discussions with the Belleville BIA regarding their opt-in program, it was determined that a successful program would require significant support from the police. Belleville has a municipal police force, whereas Orillia uses the Ontario Provincial Police which may have a less direct mandate around community policing programs. Staff, the chair and secretary would like to meet with Sgt. Stoner to potentially create a Downtown Orillia Trespass Program. The board would also like to send a letter from council to explore bylaws to prevent housing people in public facing shop alcoves or providing shelter without adequate access to washrooms.
